**STUDENT DROP OFF & PICK UP** - Here are some quick tips and guidelines to follow for student drop off and pick up.

### DROP OFFS:

Parents drop off and pick-ups are in the BACK of the building.

**Doors Open at 8:00am.** Please do not drop off students before this time, as there will be no one on duty until 8:00 am. **BELL RINGS AT 8:25 AND CLASS STARTS AT 8:30 AM**

### PICK UPS:

Dismissal times are:

K - 2:15 / Preschool 2:30 / 1st - 5th 3:00 pm

### DO NOT ARRIVE BEFORE:

Kindergarten 2:00 pm

Preschool 2:25 pm

1st - 5th 2:45 pm

**\*If you arrive prior to the designated time you will be asked to come back later, as it will create a traffic jam for the other dismissals.**

Please have your student's name posted on the rear driver's side window of your vehicle.

Please STAY IN YOUR CAR. The duty teacher will deliver your student to you.

Please, have students load on the LEFT hand side of the car. (this is a great way for your child to practice buckling their own seat belt to speed up the process)
