Dear Tiger Families,

We have arrived at the end of two Fabulous weeks of school. It's been absolutely wonderful to see staff & students in the building working so hard these past two weeks. While we have been faced with some student quarantines already, we continue to follow guidance from Cooper County Public Health and follow CDC recommendations. As students are quarantined, our teachers are committed to connecting with them to ensure they continue to receive instruction through Google Classroom, Zoom, Email and/or Class DoJo. I appreciate the cooperation from families we've had so far when dealing with quarantines.

I know our students are looking forward to a long Labor Day weekend and enjoying the final weekend of summer. I ask that when students return to school next Tuesday and for all school days that you ensure they are not experiencing symptoms of illness before coming to school. Currently, students dealing with positive cases initially thought their symptoms were that of seasonal allergies. Please do not discount symptoms your child may have, and certainly give Nurse Gina a call if you would like to discuss your child's symptoms.

Just a reminder of Quarantine Policy per Cooper County Public Health:

1. Students (ages 12 and older) who are fully vaccinated do not have to quarantine after an exposure. Proof of vaccination status must be provided. If your child has been vaccinated, you can go ahead and send Nurse Gina a copy of the vaccination card to keep on file.
2. Students who have had COVID in the past 90 days do not have to quarantine after an exposure. Proof of a COVID positive result would have to be provided to Nurse Gina. At home test will not be allowed.

The district is hosting a COVID vaccination clinic on Friday, September 10 at 9am provided by CCPH. If you would like your child 12 or older to be vaccinated, please contact the office and we will send you the required form to sign.

The District's goal remains to keep all students and staff safe while moving forward with in-seat instruction utilizing the safety protocols that were put in place with our Safe Return Plan.

Thank you for your support as we work to keep everyone safe.
