

PROCEDURES FOR SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINTS FOR PIONEER PLEASANT VALE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

CHAIN OF COMMAND

Whenever a concern or problem develops in Pioneer Pleasant Vale Public Schools it is important to communicate about the problem or concern, and investigate possible solutions, if any, for the problem or concern. Every attempt possible will be made to accommodate all concerns.

PPV Schools uses the Chain of Command procedure to address a concern or problem. When a concern or problem is brought by a parent/guardian, it should be brought to the attention of the person or the concern or problem is associated. If a resolution is not found then the parent/guardian is encouraged to proceed to the next level. Ultimately, if no amicable resolution is found by the school, the parent has the right to stand before the school board.
