A. <u>PURPOSE:</u>

The Collingswood Board of Education is seeking proposals from qualified respondents as follows:

Online Synchronous World Language (French) Instruction

B. <u>SCOPE OF SERVICE</u>:

The Board of Education desires to contract with an Online Synchronous World Language (French) Instruction service to provide Online Synchronous French Instruction for the benefit of our children during the 2023-2024 school year. Applicants should demonstrate knowledge and experience with respect to all aspects of French world language instruction by licensed and trained instructors. Any experience or knowledge of matters that directly affect the Board of Education should be addressed.

C. <u>QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS OF RESPONDENTS</u>:

- 1. Trained world language teachers.
- 2. Research-based Pedagogical Practices.
- 3. Must have a minimum of ten (3) years of experience in providing Online Synchronous French Instruction.
- 4. Data on student engagement and performance must be provided.
- 5. Must list past and present New Jersey school boards of education served.
- 6. Must provide pricing for full academic of French instruction.

The Board of Education shall utilize a one hundred (100) point system in evaluating proposals.

D. <u>CONTRACT PERIOD</u>:

The term of contract for Request for Proposal of Occupational Therapy Services shall be from September 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

The Collingswood Board of Education seeks from all participating respondents information that will assist the district in selecting the respondent who will provide the highest quality services at a fair and competitive price.

All respondents shall prepare a presentation package to be submitted with the RFP.

All respondents shall submit evidence and documentation highlighting qualifications and experience they have that will assist the district in the evaluation and selection process.

All respondents are to submit a fee proposal that compliments the service that is being requested. Monthly cost for full academic year of French instruction.

I. <u>EVALUATION OF PROPOSALS</u>:

A committee has been selected to evaluate proposals that have been submitted. Committee members are familiar with the need for services to be performed in the Request for Proposal. Committee members will be identified in the final report submitted to the board and also in the award of contract resolution.

J. <u>AWARD OF CONTRACT</u>

It is the intention of the Board of Education to award the contract to the respondent based upon relative experience, qualifications, and who will provide the highest quality of service at fair and competitive prices.

K. <u>AUTHORIZATION TO WORK</u>:

No service shall be rendered unless the successful respondent receives an approved purchase order authorizing the respondent to render the service.

L. <u>DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED WITH THE PROPOSAL</u>:

- Affirmative Action Questionnaire;
- Stockholders Disclosure Statement;
- Vendor Questionnaire/Certification;
- New Jersey Business Registration Certificate;
- Chapter 271 Political Contribution Disclosure Form;

- Certificate of Insurance- General Commercial Liability \$1,000,000, Professional Liability \$2,000,000, and Workers' Compensation-Statutorystating "Collingswood Public Schools as an additional insured on a primary insurance coverage basis".

M. <u>CONTRACTS</u>:

Upon notification of award of contract by the Collingswood Board of Education, the successful respondent shall sign and execute a formal contract agreement with the Board of Education.

The successful respondent shall sign and execute said contract and return it together with documents required by the district such as but not limited to:

- Professional Liability Certificate;
- Criminal History Background evidence;
- Other required documents as may be outlined in the proposal specifications.

N. <u>AFFIRMATIVE ACTION REQUIREMENTS</u>:

Each respondent shall submit to the public agency, after notification of award but prior to execution of a goods and services contract, one of the following three documents:

- i. Appropriate evidence that the respondent is operating under an existing federally approved or sanctioned affirmative action program; or
- ii. A certificate of employee information report approval issued in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-4; or
- iii. An employee information report (Form AA302) provided by the Division and distributed to the public agency to be completed by the contractor, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-4.

O. <u>BUSINESS REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE</u> (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44)

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:42-44 as amended by P.L. 2004 – Chapter 57, all respondents shall submit with their proposal package a copy of their "New Jersey Business Registration Certificate" as issued by the Department of Treasury of the State of New Jersey. Failure to provide the New Jersey Business Registration Certification with the proposal package may be cause for the rejection of the entire proposal.

Goods and Services

N.J.S.A. 52:32-44 imposes the following requirements on contractors and all subcontractors that **knowingly** provide goods or perform services for a contractor fulfilling this contract: 1) The contractor shall provide written notice to its subcontractors to submit proof of business registration to the contractor; 2) prior to receipt of final payment from a contracting agency, a contractor must submit to the contracting agency an accurate list of all subcontractors or attest that none was used; and

3) during the term of this contract, the contractor and its affiliates shall collect, remit, and notify all subcontractors and their affiliates that they must collect and remit to the Director of the New Jersey Division of Taxation, the use tax due pursuant to the Sales and Use Tax Act (N.J.S.A. 54:32B-1 et seq.) on all sales of tangible personal property delivered into this State.

A contractor, subcontractor, or supplier who fails to provide proof of business registration or provides false business registration information shall be liable to a penalty of \$25 for each day of violation, not to exceed \$50,000 for each business registration not properly provided or maintained under a contract with a contracting agency. Information on the law and its requirements is available by calling (609)292-9292.

P. <u>TERMINATION OF CONTRACT</u>

If the Board determines that the contractor has failed to comply with the terms and conditions of the bid and/or proposal upon which the issuance of the contract is based or that the contractor has failed to perform said service, duties, and/or efficient manner, then the Board shall have the authority to terminate the contract upon written notice setting forth the reason for termination and effective date of termination.

Termination by the Board of the contract does not resolve the contractor from potential liability for damages caused the District by the contractor's breach of this agreement. The Board may withhold payment due the contractor and apply same towards damages once established. The Board will act diligently in accordance with governing statutes to mitigate damages. Damages may include the additional cost of procuring said services or goods from other sources.

The contractor further agrees to indemnify and hold the District harmless from any liability to subcontractors or suppliers concerning work performed or goods provided arising out of the lawful termination of this agreement.

Q. FALSE MATERIAL REPRESENTATION - N.J.S.A. 2C:21-34-97(b)

A person commits a crime if the person knowingly makes a material representation that is false in connection with the negotiation, award, or performance of a government contract. If the contract amount is for \$25,000.00 or above, the offender is guilty of a crime of the second degree. If the contract amount exceeds \$2,500.00, but is less than \$25,000.00, the offender is guilty of a crime of the third degree. If the contract amount is for \$2,500.00 or less, the offender is guilty of a crime of the fourth degree.

R. <u>POLITICAL CONDTRIBUTION DISCLOSURE STATEMENT – PAY TO PLAY</u>

A business entity as defined by law is advised of its responsibility to file an annual disclosure statement on political contributions with the **New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission** pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44a-20.13 (P.L. 2005 Chapter 271 Section 3) if the business entity receives contracts in excess of \$50,000 from public entities in a calendar year. It is the business entity's responsibility to determine if filing is necessary. Additional information on this requirement is available from the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission at 1-888-313-3532 or at <u>www.elec.nj.us</u>. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-6-3 (a1-4) please note the following:

<u>Award of Contract</u> - Reportable Contributions – N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-6.3 (a2) "No board of education will vote upon or award any contract in the amount of \$17,500 or greater to any business entity which has made a contribution reportable by the recipient under P.L. 1973, c83 (codified as N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 et. seq.) to a member of the board of education during the preceding one year period."

<u>Contributions During Term of Contract</u> – Prohibited – N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-6.3 (a2,3) "Contributions reportable by the recipient under P.L. 1973, c83 (codified at N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 et. seq.) to any member of the school board from any business entity doing business with the school district are prohibited during the term of the contract."

"When a business entity referred in 4.1(e) is a natural person, contribution by that person's spouse or child that resides therewith, shall be deemed to be a contribution by the business entity. When a business entity is other than a natural person, a contribution by any person or other business entity having an interest therein shall be deemed to be a contribution by the business entity."

<u>Chapter 271 Political Contribution Disclosure Form – Required – N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-6-3</u> All bidders shall submit with their bid package a completed and signed Chapter 271 Political Contribution Disclosure Form. The Chapter 271 form will be reviewed by the district to determine whether the vendor is in compliance with the aforementioned N.J.A.C. 6a:23a-6.3 (A2) Award of Contract.

S. <u>INTERPRETATIONS AND ADDENDA</u>

No interpretation of the meaning of the specifications will be made to any Respondent orally. Every request for such interpretation should be made in writing to the Purchasing Agent and must be received at least ten (10) days prior to the date fixed for the opening of Proposals to be given consideration. Any and all interpretations and any supplemental instructions will be distributed in the form of a written addenda to the specifications. The addenda will be provided in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18a:18A-21 to the respondents by certified mail or certified fax no later than seven (7) days, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays excepted, prior to the date for acceptance of Proposals. All addenda so issued shall become part of the contract document.

T. <u>SUBCONTRACTING; ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT</u>

Contractors, services providers, and all vendors with whom the Board of Education has an executed contract may not subcontract any part of any work done or consign any contract for goods or materials for the Board without first receiving written permission from the Purchasing Agent.

The respondent by signing this proposal form, acknowledges that he/she has carefully examined the proposal specifications and documents; and further acknowledges he/she understands and is able to render the scope of activity and services outlined in the proposal.
