

DTHS After School Study Program 2021-2022

Dwight Township High School will be utilizing the After School Study Program (ASSP) for the 2021-2022 school year. This program will provide students who are failing a class with additional opportunities to work with teachers to successfully complete courses and remain on track for educational success and graduation. The ASSP is a mandatory program that students who are failing one or more classes will be expected to participate in. Please see the bulleted information below. - Transportation will be provided to any student who needs a ride home at 4:15
- A snack will be provided to any student who attends the ASSP
- Any student who is failing a class will be expected to attend the ASSP
- A D/F list will be generated every Sunday at 12:00pm and this list will be used to determine who must attend the ASSP
- The ASSP will be every Tuesday and Thursday from 3:15-4:15
- Students who are unexcused absent from ASSP will serve a lunch detention for the first three times they miss. The fourth and any additional unexcused absences will result in five lunch detentions
- ASSP absences will be labeled as excused or unexcused based on the typical school guidelines
