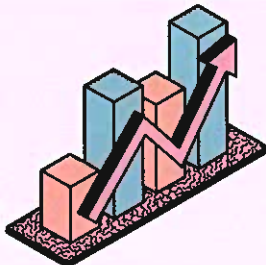


EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?



Eligible Households can receive:

- Up to \$50/month discount for broadband services
- Up to \$75/month discount for broadband services for households on qualifying Tribal Lands

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Qualifies for the FCC's Lifeline Program, including those who are on Medicaid or receive SNAP benefits
- Approved for the free or reduced-price school breakfast/lunch program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)
- Experienced a substantial documented loss of income since February 29, 2020 and the household had a total income in 2020 below \$99,00 for single filers and \$198,00 for joint filers
- Received a federal Pell grant in the current award year
- Qualifies for a participating provider's existing low-income or COVID-19 relief program, subject to FCC approval of the provider's eligibility process

Contact a participating broadband provider directly to learn about their application process. If you cannot apply through them directly, you can apply using option 2 or 3.

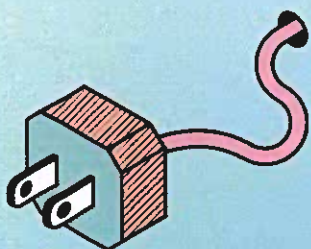
Go online to GetEmergencyBroadband.org to apply and find participating providers in your area. Once you apply you will need to contact a participating provider to select an eligible plan.
