- 1. The meeting was called to order by President Demetrius Colvin, Sr. A prayer was given by Ande Bostain, and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Brian Jaeger.

3. Principals' Report

- a. Karen Steenken, secondary campus principal reported that tutorials for retesting will be held June 16, 2015 through July 2015. She also reported that Robert Reyes has been employed as a Spanish teacher for school year 2015-2016. Mrs. Steenken will be interviewing an applicant for the history/coach position on Tuesday.
