<u>Liturgical Ministries</u>
Altar Care Volunteer—Volunteers work in groups to clean the sanctuary and sacristy before weekend masses
Altar Linens Volunteer— Volunteers take altar linens home, launder them according to the proper procedure iron them and then return them to the sacristy.
Sacristan— Assist with setting up before weekend liturgies one half hour before mass begins.
Greeter/Usher—Welcome worshippers before the Eucharistic celebration, seat & assist those in need, gather the collection, assist with the procession of the gifts & Communion procession, and distribute bulletins.
Lector—Volunteers age 16 and older have the privilege of sharing God's Word in a clear and dignified manner initial training and yearly renewal required.
Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion—The privilege and honor to communicate the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ to the faithful either at mass or to the sick and homebound.

Faith Formation Ministries
Eucharistic Adoration Chapel—Volunteers devote one hour a week in quiet prayer, reflection and adoration of Our Lord in the adoration chapel during open hours (Mon—Thurs 3pm-9pm, Friday 3pm to 7pm).
Youth Ministry—for students grades 9 through 12. Group meets almost every Sunday after the 6pm mass to grow in spirituality, knowledge and service. Adult volunteers needed.
Altar & Rosary Society—An organization of women with special devotion to the Blessed Mother, meet on a monthly basis.
RCIA Volunteer—Volunteers support the RCIA program either by serving as sponsors to candidates or by providing meals to the RCIA group. RCIA meets during the school year, Tuesday after the 5:30pm mass.
Funeral Luncheon—Volunteers prepare dishes and/or give their time to serving at funeral lunches.
Prayer Chain —Volunteers pray for requested needs & pass on prayer requests to other chain members.
Arts & Environment– Decorating & assisting with liturgical and seasonal changes throughout the year.
Sons of St. Joseph Men's Group– Men's organization, meets monthly to discuss and bond through faith.
<u>Children's Ministries</u>
Religious Education Catechist— instructors teach the student who Jesus is and invite the student into a close relationship with Jesus. Sunday mornings from 9:15-10:15. Preparation for the lessons requires at least two hours.
Vacation Bible School Volunteer—Catholic Kids Camp takes place at the end of June. Volunteers are needed in all areas of the camp: Bible presentations, crafts, music, snacks, interactive games, and teen leaders.
