

NOTICE

To the parents of Children Who Attend School Lane Charter School Programs for Students with a Disability and (Child Find) Protected Handicap Students

IDEA-Chapter 14: in compliance with state and federal law, notice is hereby given by School Lane Charter School that it conducts ongoing identification activities as part of its school program for the purpose of identifying students who may be in need of special education and related services. If your child is identified by SLCS as possibly in need of such services, you will be notified of applicable procedures. Individualized services and programs are available for children who are determined to need specially designed instruction due to the following conditions.

1. Autism/pervasive development disorder
2. Blindness or visual impairment
3. Deafness or hearing impairment
4. Deaf Blindness
5. Orthopedic impairment
6. Development delay impairment
7. Multiple disabilities
8. Traumatic brain injury
9. Other health impairment
10. Emotional disturbance
11. Specific learning disability
12. Speech or language

If you believe that your school-aged child may be in need of special education services and related programs, screening and evaluation processes designed to assess the need of the child and his/her eligibility are available to you at no cost, upon written request. You may request screening and evaluation at any time. Requests for evaluation and screening are to be made in writing to the principal of your child's school or the Learning Support Services, School Lane Charter School, 2400 Bristol Pike, Bensalem, PA 19020.

Section 504-Chapter 15: In compliance with state and federal law, the School will provide to each protected handicapped student, without discrimination or cost to the student or family, those related aids, services or accommodations which are needed to provide equal opportunity to participate in and obtain the benefits of the school program and extracurricular activities to the maximum extent appropriate to the student's abilities. A protected handicapped student must be school age with a physical or mental disability which substantially limits or prohibits participation in or access to an aspect of the school program. You may request screening and evaluation for Chapter 15 services at any time. Requests for evaluation and screening are to be made in writing to the principal of your child's school or Learning Support Services, School Lane Charter School, 2400 Bristol Pike, Bensalem, PA 19020.
