We understand that members of our community struggle with the cost of internet services in the home. In the past, the school had HotSpot devices to provide to some families. The program that paid for the HotSpots is no longer available to the school district. However, there is a new program that is available to families. The Emergency Broadband Program was created by the FCC to provide families financial assistance for internet service in the home. Attached is information about the program and how to apply to receive the benefit. We hope this program provides for the needed resource to help students complete their homework and online classes in the event it is necessary to transition to remote learning at any point this school year.
