FINAL EXAMS

Student Final Exam Incentive



- Students may be able to opt out of taking the final exam ONLY if they meet the requirements below. This "opt out" is decided by each individual course.
 - Must have at least a 70% in the course at the cut-off date.
 - No more than two tardies to the class.
 - No skips or evening detentions.
 - No Out of School Suspensions or In-School Interventions.

Students who meet the opt-out requirements can still elect to take the final exam for any course to attempt to increase their grade.

PCHS DRESS CODE

Clothing, accessories, make-up, and hair color should in no way distract from the learning environment at school or school activities nor should they create a danger to the health and safety of the students.

School personnel reserve the right to make determinations on acceptable appearance and dress.

- Masks are required, and must be worn over the nose and mouth.
- Shirts with sleeves covering the entire torso and shoulders are required.
- Pants, jeans, shorts, dresses, and skirts must extend to at least mid-thigh.
- When wearing leggings (including knit jeggings) and yoga pants, the top must cover the pelvic region and buttocks.
- No pants may have holes above mid-thigh.
- No undergarments of any kind may be exposed.
- Pajamas/pajama pants are not acceptable attire.
- As a health and safety measure, all students must wear shoes. (slippers are not allowed)

Students who choose to dress in a manner not appropriate for school will be instructed to change their clothing before they will be admitted to class.

Hallway Social Distancing




- Stay to your right


