Monitoring Exited TBIP Students Procedure

- When students transition from receiving English Language Development (ELD) services based on state requirements (currently WIDA ACCESS or Alternate ACCESS scores), Wahluke School District will monitor them for at least two years to ensure that:
 - A. Students were not exited prematurely.
 - B. Students are meeting challenging state standards.
 - C. Students are meaningfully participating in the standard instructional program comparable to their never-EL peers.
- 2. To monitor students, a survey will be sent out at the end of each semester to the following teachers:
 - A. K-5 Homeroom teacher
 - B. 6-12 Advisor, ELA and Math teachers
- 3. The survey will include information on student academic performance, English language development skills and a recommendation to continue monitoring or recommendation for additional interventions.
