

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT IN BUFFALO STADIUM

In order to preserve order and to protect the rights of all spectators at GISD football games in Buffalo Stadium, we ask that everyone who attends the game abide by the following:

All students not seated with their parents must sit in the student section!

Students are to remain in the stands during the game. High school students may leave to the concession stand, but must return to their seat. Intermediate and Middle School students will be allowed to leave the stands with two minutes remaining in the first half, or two minutes remaining in the second half. Otherwise, a parent must come pick them up in order for them to leave early. If by chance the stadium becomes overcrowded, we may allow spectators to sit with the students.

No students are allowed to stand on the top row of the bleachers at any time.

Parents are not allowed to drop off a child under the age of 12, to the football game. Parents should supervise the children who enter with them.

Students will not be allowed to run in the stands or congregate under the stands or anywhere else.

Spectators are to leave the walkways, steps, and ramps clear at all times. This includes the front rail of the bleachers.

GISD students are to remain on the home side at all times. Visiting students are to remain on the visiting side at all times.

GISD dress code does apply at all sporting events. (Home and away)

All students found in violation of any rules will be turned over to the campus principal or assistant principal.

Law enforcement representatives will be available to give assistance as needed. Violators of stadium rules will be dismissed from the game and may be removed from the remaining home games.

We ask that everyone follow these general guidelines so that watching the games will be safer and more enjoyable for everyone.
