Dear Parents and Guardians,

There have been some changes from the FC-CHD regarding quarantine requirements. All students under the age of 12 MUST quarantine, if they are a close contact to a positive Covid-19 case. We are experiencing a high number of cases already, with at least 24 confirmed Covid-19 cases and 60 plus close contact quarantines. We will have a tab on our website that will be updated regularly showing how many positive Covid-19 cases there have been, number of people quarantined and amount of school days missed due to positive cases and or close contact quarantine. Please have your child tested if they show any of the following symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4 or higher
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- Loss of taste or smell
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Muscle ache
- Sore throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Runny nose or congestion
- You should be symptom free for 24 hours before returning to school
- If symptoms last more than 48 hours you should consult a physician

Teachers will be doing videos and other methods to reach out and introduce themselves to you.
