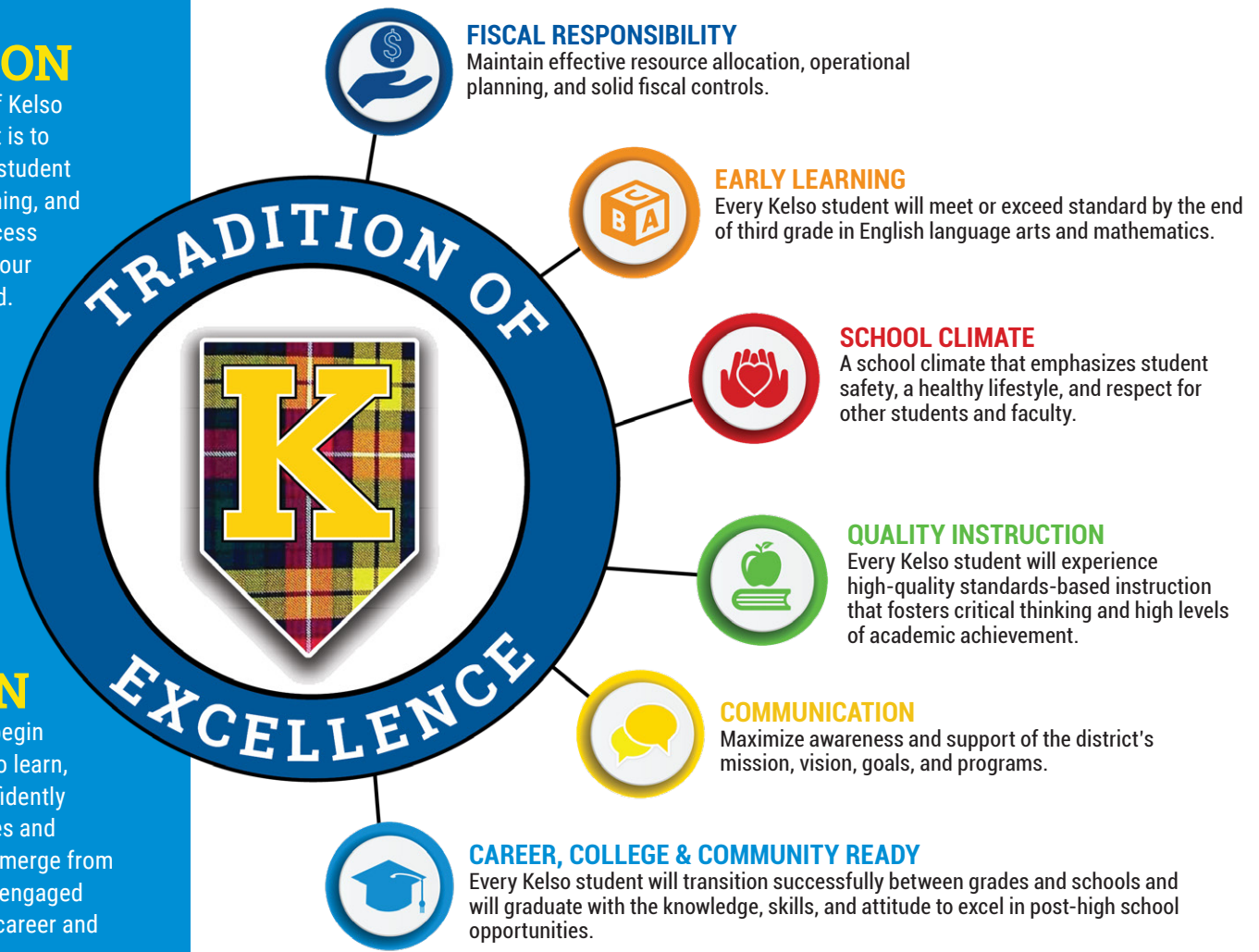

The mission of Kelso School District is to prepare every student for living, learning, and achieving success as a citizen of our changing world.

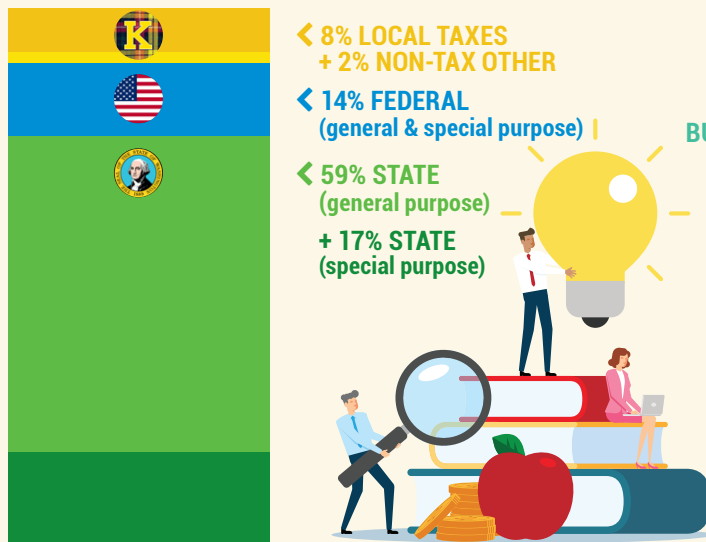
VISION

Our students begin school ready to learn, transition confidently between grades and schools, and emerge from our district as engaged citizens, both career and college-ready.

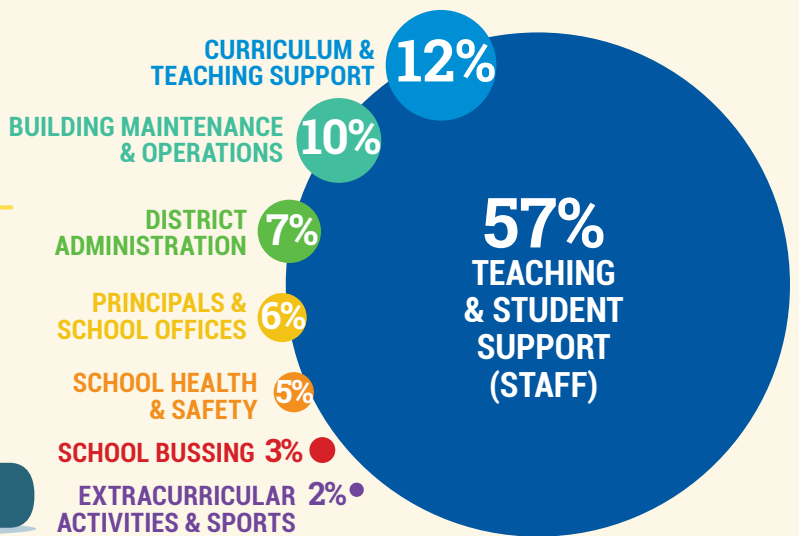


2021-22 FINANCIALS

Revenue & its sources:



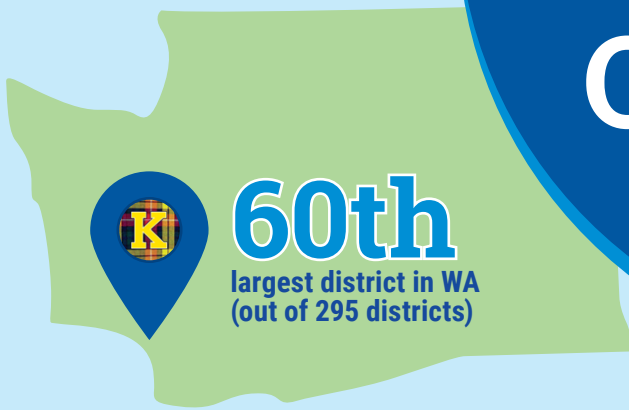
Expenditures by category:

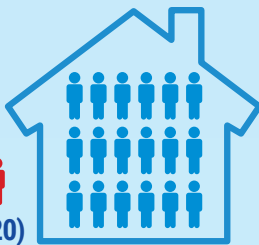
OUR DISTRICT SNAPSHOT

(2 students in every class of 20)



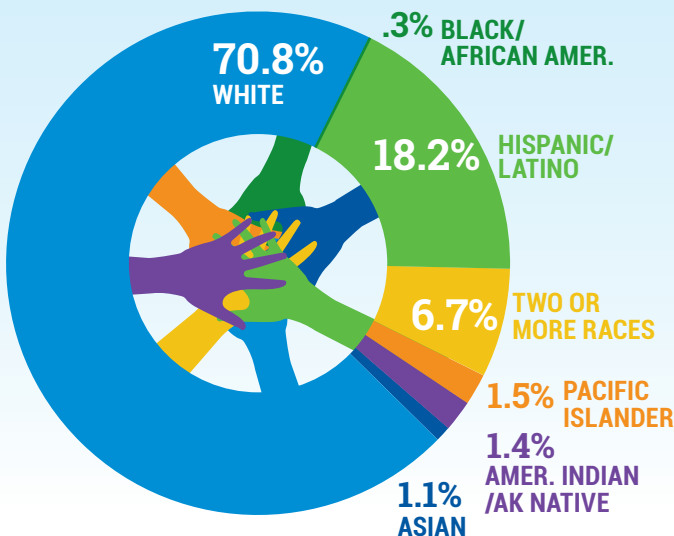
16% of students receive special education

7% of students are highly capable (HiCap)

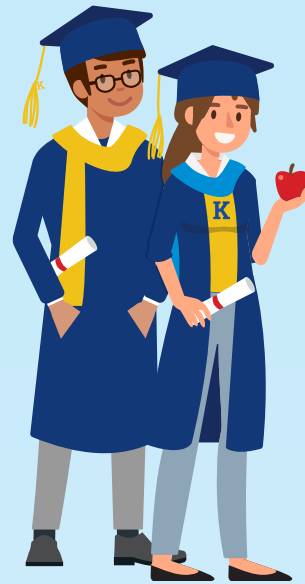
6% of students are English language learners

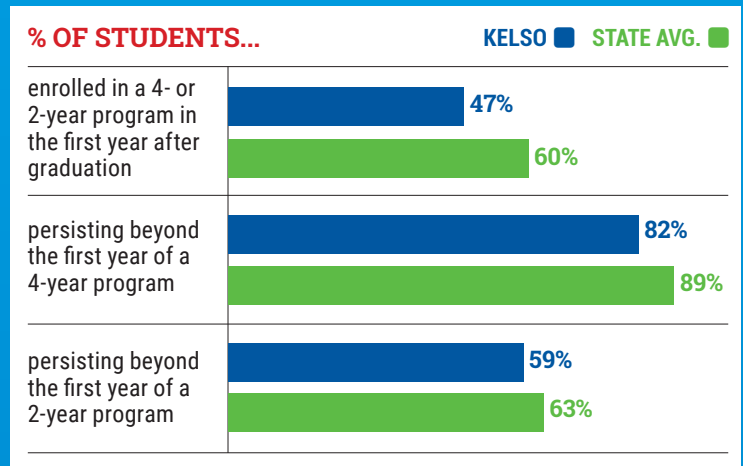


For the past five years our graduation rate has continued to climb, bringing us closer to...
