

## APPLICATION FOR EARLY HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

The Board of Education authorizes graduation for students who meet the following criteria:

- 1. Have satisfied course requirements for graduation;
- 2. Have demonstrated how an alternative to continuing their high school education would be more profitable to them;
- 3. Have parental/legal guardian permission for early graduation; and
- 4. Have submitted this application no later than the first day of school of the student's junior year.

<u>Graduation Policy 217</u>: A minimum of twenty-four (24) credits must be acquired during the last four (4) years of high school in order for a student to graduate. A student must take a minimum of six (6) credits per year. The fourth year of high school shall not be required for graduation if a student has completed all requirements for graduation. An application for early graduation must be approved by the superintendent no later than the first day of school of the student's junior year.

No student who has completed the requirements for graduation shall be denied a diploma as a disciplinary measure, but s/he may be denied participation in the ceremony of graduation when personal conduct so warrants. Such exclusion shall be regarded as a school suspension. Any student who has received approval for early graduation but fails to meet all graduation requirements by the proposed graduation date or who fails to meet any other requirement set forth in his/her individual early graduation agreement, must re-enroll for a program of courses.
