Newsletter

As a way to communicate on a regular basis with our families, you will receive a Warrior Newsletter by email every Friday. This will provide important information and details about upcoming events at school to help you support your children at home and be engaged in our school activities. School Hours

Doors open at 7:30 AM. Please remember that each grade level has an entry point and that information was in "The Back to School" letter and on the map provided in that envelope. We will have staff helping on the first day of school. Students can hang out in their hallways and Library before school. School releases at 3:40 PM and we will need everyone to exit the building by 3:45 PM. **NO OUTSIDE VISITORS, PARENTS AT THIS TIME.**

Cell Phones

OFF and AWAY! All cell phones need to be turned off during the school day and kept in their lockers. If they take them to class then they are not seen and only used when a teacher allows them too. If a cell phone is seen a teacher will remind the student to put it OFF and AWAY. If the student does not comply with the teacher's direction then the teacher will take the phone away and turn it into the principal's office. The student may come after school to pick up the phone. Multiple infractions will result in a parent phone call and possible referral. As a parent I understand that you want to get a hold of your child at a moment's notice but we need to have an environment to learn and phones are a huge distraction. If you need to get a hold of your child call the front office and we will get a message, note, and have your child call you ASAP. We will be reviewing this policy Tuesday during Advisory.

Advisory

Advisory is a class on Tuesday/Thursday at Oakridge JR/SR High. It meets for 35 minutes and covers lots of important information such as College/Career Readiness, How to Navigate School and your classes, study hall, HS Matters, 8th Gr Matters, Care and Connection and several other topics throughout the year. In 7th and 8th grade they are mixed grade level and will have their teacher for 2 years. For 7th/8th/9th grade, academic planners are required to be filled out in every classroom so students know what they learned that day and possible homework assignments. Advisory teachers will support our students in filling that out and keeping it up to date. If you want to know if your student has homework or what they did in school today please ask to see this planner. Hopefully next week your student will be filling it out for every class. For

9th-12th grade students will have their advisory teacher for all four years of high school. This way they have a strong connection with a group of their peers and an adult in our building. These students will guide them through Organization skills, study skills, time management and College/Career Readiness. For the rest of this month we will also be covering the Student Handbook.

Student Handbook

During Advisory teachers will be going over the Student Handbook for a small amount of time in advisory. Each week will be certain parts of the handbook. As soon as our website is updated we will post our Student Handbook for your reference. Next week we will be reviewing the dress code, cell phones, and Bullying and Harassment.
