

VOYAGER DISCOVER SCHEDULE:

Each week, students will be asked to complete a variety of activities in Discover. The following explains what they will work on each day:

VOYAGER MISSING HOMEWORK POLICY:

Work that is not completed on time may receive a zero or partial credit based on the teacher's discretion. For frequently missed assignments, parents may be notified by email. Excessive missing assignments across multiple classes may result in a parent conference and office referral. Each grading period, students will have a clean slate and begin the process over again.

VOYAGER TARDY POLICY:

Students must arrive to class on time. A student is considered TARDY, if they are not in their seat before the end of the bell. Tardies will be addressed as follows:

1st tardy to class -Verbal warning2nd tardy to class -Parent notification3rd tardy and up -Office referral
