For the best history of a PERSON or PLACE that played an important part in the history of Sequoyah County:

The winners in each of 3 age categories will receive a prize of \$250

Age Categories: 6-12 years of age; 13-15 years of age; 16-19 years of age

RULES:

1. Choose someone or a place that little is known about. Your history can be about one of your own relatives or property if they played an important part in the history of Sequoyah County.
2. Your history must be original, not copied, and between 200 – 500 words.
3. You can use other stories, newspapers, letters, etc. as your sources but your writing must be in your own words.
4. If you use other 's writings as your source, that source or where you found your information should be stated at the end of your history.
5. Your history can be handwritten, if we can read it, otherwise it should be typed.
6. You can include pictures of persons or places with your writing.
7. Mail a COPY of your finished history with your NAME, AGE, ADDRESS, and PHONE NUMBER postmarked no later than OCTOBER 19, 2021 TO:
