AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND
PIXING A SCHEDULE OF CHARGES
FOR WATER SUPPLIED BY AND USED
IN THE TOWN OF FLEMING, LOGAN
COUNTY, COLORADO

In Botty L. Bidse, Town Clark of the Town of Floring, Colorado,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FLEMING:

Section 1. That from and after March 10, 1956, the Town of Fleming shall charge for water supplied by said Town of Fleming, Colorado, and received through each and every water tap according to the following flat rate schedule and metered rate schedule; new rates to be on a temporary trial basis.

(Residential property)

dates of March 25th and September 25th

6 months winter rate @ \$2.00 per month, billed between dates of September 25th and March 25th

A residential lot being defined as being approximately fifty feet by one hundred forty feet.

Water users with more than one lot for irrigation will pay seventy five (\$.75) cents per month additional per lot or part thereof for six months per year beginning March 25th.

COMMERCIAL OR METERED RATES

\$2.75 MINMUM First 5000 gallons 0 Colorado, this Oth 4000 gallons 0 Next .25 per thousand Next 6000 gallons 0 .15 per thousand Over 15000 gallons 0 .10 per thousand

ANY WATER USER WASTING WATER WILL BE METERED.

- Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
- Section 3. The terms and provisions of this ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect within five (5) days after its passage.
