Dear Lima Central Catholic Alumni, Parents and Friends,

I recently came across a Lima News Article dated August 4, 1973, in which Msgr. Herr was given a full page to discuss his education philosophy and changes he had witnessed over his 37 years as a principal. In the feature entitled "Change Needed to Cope: Youth Business a Challenge", Msgr. Herr stated that "the greatest thing we can do here and now is to teach them (students) friendship and affection while giving them a 'womb' to grow up in." He then added that "people need to learn how to get close to people again."

The last 18 months could certainly be described as a challenge over and above the ordinary business of educating youth. Even though we had to modify many of our traditional activities and couldn't do everything we had hoped, students and staff embraced the challenge and created memories that will always be unique to the 2020-21 school year. Live-streaming athletic events, award ceremonies and concerts were pilot projects this year, but will likely continue for the benefit of friends, family and alumni who otherwise would not be able to attend some of these events.

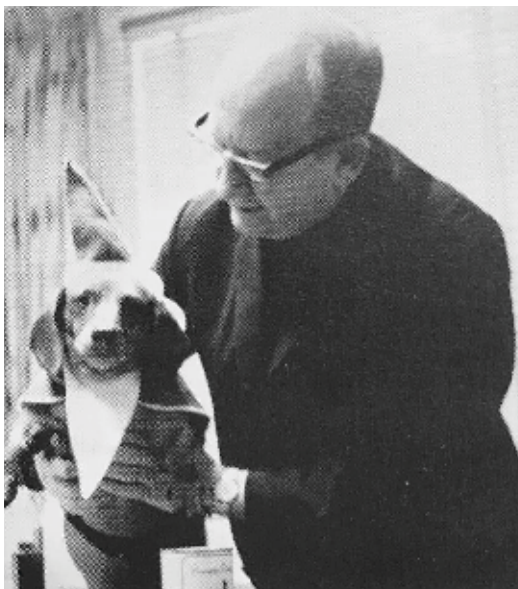
I am so proud of the many ways our students displayed leadership, their God-given talents, and resilience in the midst of a world-wide pandemic. The talent of the senior class was on full display last school year despite fewer spectators at everything from our third consecutive state championship in girls' golf to the fabulous senior class musical. We will look back on the past year of switching back and forth from in-person to online and hybrid learning as one of the greatest displays of resilience in LCC history. The ability to quickly adapt to different methods of learning was amazing and will serve students well in the future.

After nineteen years in education, eleven of which have been in administration, I couldn't agree more with Msgr. Herr's perspective. The challenges of the past year have confirmed the wisdom of Msgr. Herr's philosophy and the importance of providing a safe learning environment where students have the freedom to achieve their full potential, especially for learners who have experienced some level of trauma or other difficulty. As we enter our 66th year of education, Lima Central Catholic is committed to providing a supportive learning environment for students, to expand their sense of family and enhance their self-esteem.

In the words of the Lima News, "Youth Business can be a Challenge", and the changes implemented to meet the challenges of the public health emergency kept our students safe, learning, and on track to graduate. Msgr. Herr's legacy continues to inspire the students and staff of Lima Central Catholic. We look forward to focusing on his advice to "learn how to get close to people again."

Dear Friends,

This summer, retired long-time LCC basketball coach and guidance counselor Bob Seggerson handed me a letter he found from his archives. It was the "Back to School" letter from Principal Msgr. Herr to parents prior to the 1978-79 school year. In it, he writes about the school adapting to the blizzard of 1978, inflation, and the energy crisis. He applauds the dedicated staff of LCC, talks about the sacrifices they make to serve the Catholic schools, and stresses the importance of families making the commitment to Catholic education in an evolving culture. He even discusses advocating the government for funding parents who choose Catholic education. He implores families to be supportive of the school's fundraising efforts, boldly asking for \$10 more per month donation. In his words, "In these times of educational crisis....our traditions are holding up."

More than forty years later, we emerge from the pandemic with similar feelings of being blessed to have survived a difficult year, appreciative of the sacrifices of our staff and families for the important mission of our school, and optimistic about the future. The LCC Educational Foundation, with its Capital Campaign, has worked tirelessly to raise funds to help the school through a short-term enrollment dip set to turn around next year and ensure a sound financial future for the school. We have been able to fund a few important and long overdue capital improvement projects. We will, however, continue to need the support of our T-Bird family as we always have to address the educational needs of our students and families, maintain our facility, and invest in our quality staff.

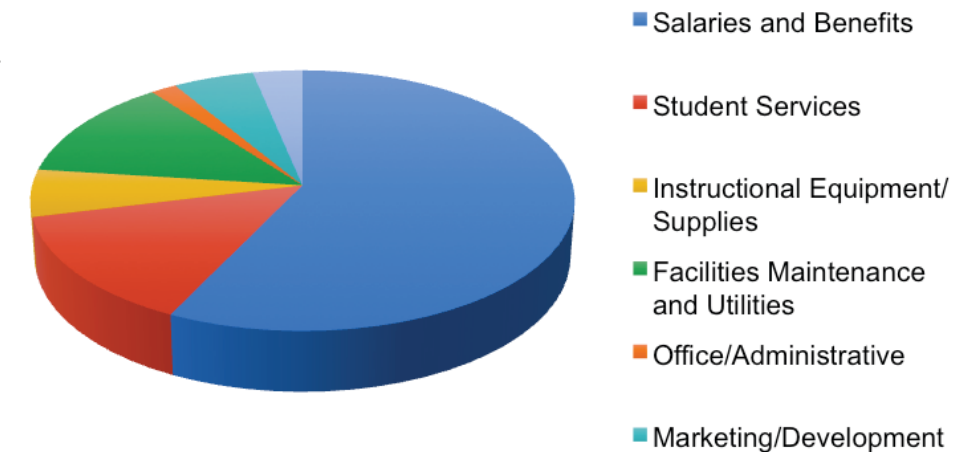
As we all shake off the fatigue caused by the pandemic, all of us at Lima Central Catholic are inspired to begin a new year.

We invite you to come to our campus and attend our events to visit old friends and see the students and staff once again. We thank you for your prayers and support throughout this school year.

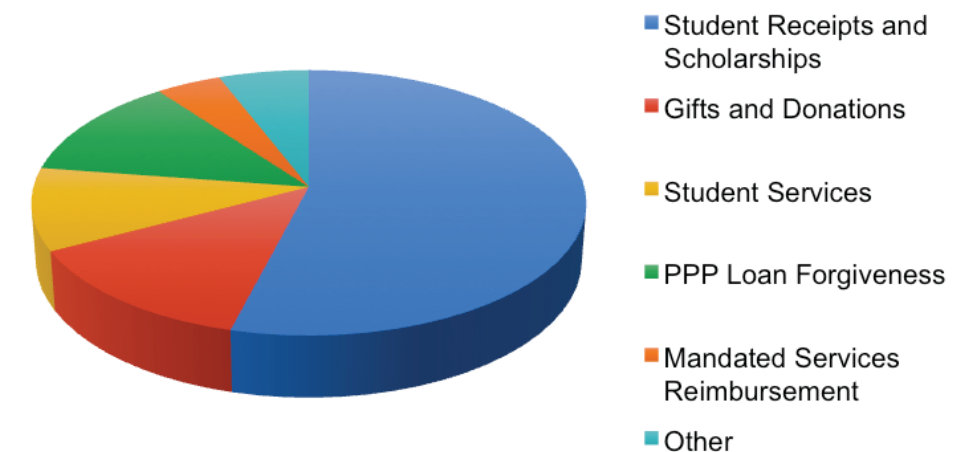

Girls Varsity Golf

Lima Central Catholic again dominated the Division II Girls Golf state tournament, claiming their third consecutive state championship! Coached by newly inducted LCC Hall of Famer, Dan Reinicke and Pete Hubbell, the team again broke their own 36 hole state tournament scoring record with a 630 and won by an astounding 53 strokes over Tuscarawas Valley. Seniors Erin Mulcahy and Mary Kelly Mulcahy earned 1st Team All-Ohio honors and are both headed to play for the University of Findlay this fall. Juniors Emma Mayers, Carlie Van Meter and Sophomore Bridget Mulcahy also competed again this year. Other team members included juniors Olivia Garver and Leiahnni Smith.



Football

The Thunderbirds were one of the most explosive teams in Division VII football this past fall, reaching the state semi-finals before losing a heartbreaker to New Bremen. Nonetheless, Coach Scott Palte's squad finished the season 8-2, with numerous players garnering All-State recognition. Seniors Shaun Thomas (Univ. of Cincinnati), Rahsaan Moore (Mount Union), Zac Jacobs (Wittenburg) and Nathan Davisson.



Wrestling

After reaching the 2020 state tournament only to have it cancelled due to Covid-19 the day before it began, junior Gavin Caprella went to work and once again qualified in 2021. In the 113lb. weight class, Gavin went 31-5, captured his 100th career win, and ultimately finished 5th in Division III. He becomes LCC's 11th state placer in program history.

LCC's Boys Golf team qualified for the Division III Boys Golf state tournament for the first time in a number of years, finishing 8th place. Coach Dave Schmiedebusch's T-Birds were led by seniors Ross Otto, Alex Wissner, Casey Koenig, and Brady Koenig along with standout freshman Parker Judy.

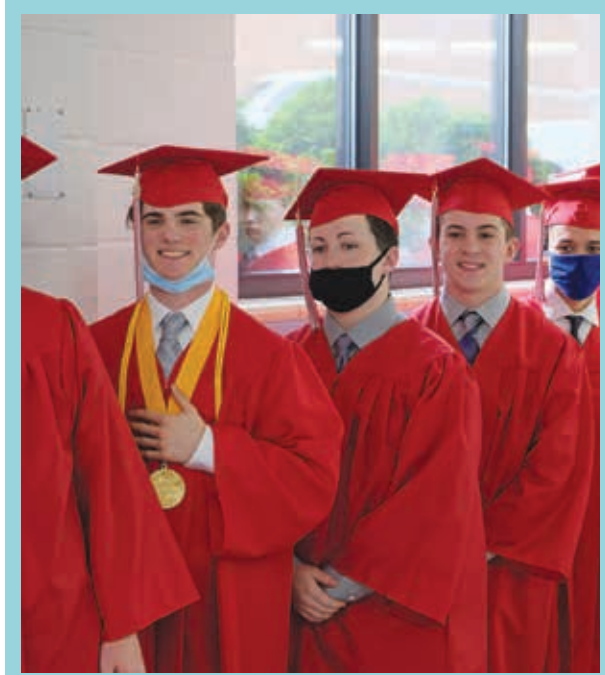
2021 GRADUATION

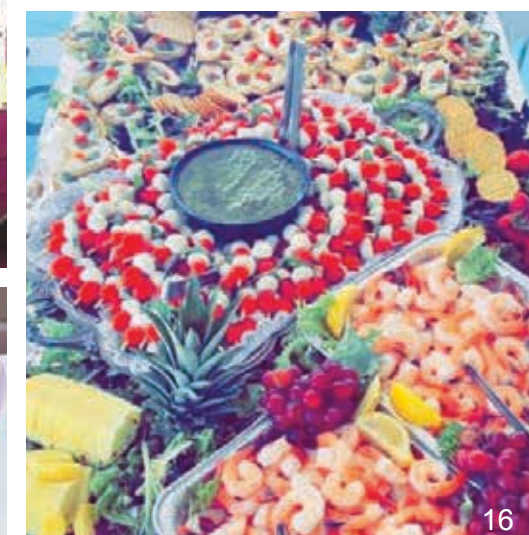

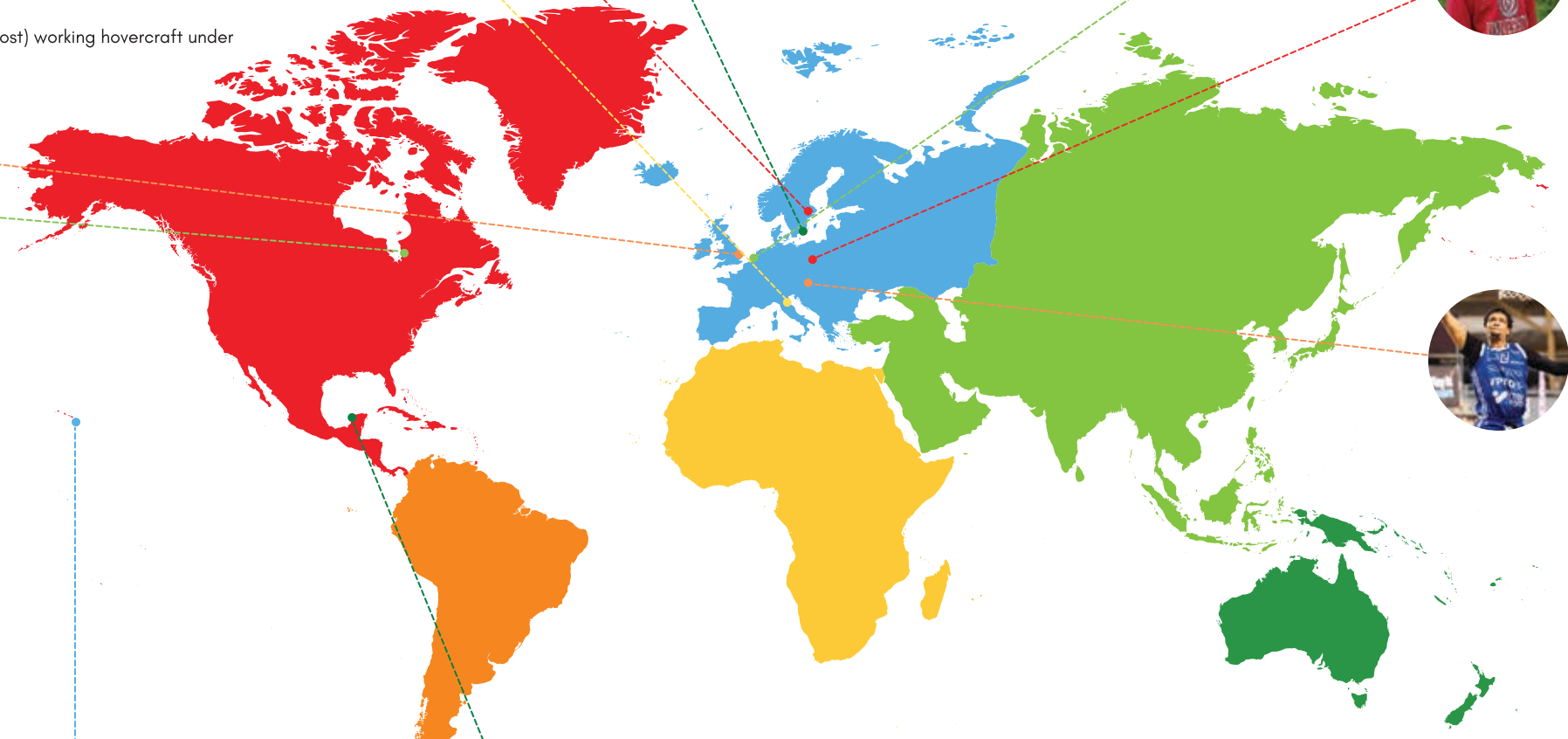

Absorbing the street and market foods, and the energy of these diverse cultures, led to the opening of Compass Rose upon her return to DC in 2014. The pioneering restaurant dedicated to global flavors went on to be named the 2017 RAMMY award-winner for best casual restaurant, and appeared on every best restaurant list in DC, and garnered national recognition from esteemed outlets including The New York Times, The Los Angeles Times, Food & Wine, Bon Appetit, and more.

In 2017, Rose opened Maydan, tucked away in an alley in DC's U Street neighborhood. The restaurant was conceived in the summer of 2016 on a three-week journey through Morocco, Tunisia, Turkey, Georgia and Lebanon where the team immersed themselves in local culinary traditions, techniques, and ingredients from the countries they visited. Maydan debuted and quickly earned coveted spots on "Best New Restaurants in America" lists from national media including Bon Appetit, Food & Wine, GQ, Eater, was named a James Beard Award Semifinalist and in 2019 earned a Michelin Star.

Rose was the host of local PBS affiliate WETA's "Check, Please! DC" where she guided viewers through an unfiltered look at the local restaurant scene. As a prominent and progressive small business entrepreneur, she has attracted recognition including Washingtonian's "40 Under 40" in 2017 as a local figure who is shaping the community and in 2019 on its "Most Powerful Women in Washington," as one of the area's most influential leaders.
