OUR SYSTEM FOR DROPPING OFF STUDENTS IN THE MORNING AND PICKING THEM UP AT The End of the day works well, if we all do our part!

MORNING

Students can be dropped off in either the left or right lane. The right lane is preferred so your child doesn't have to cross traffic.

If you must park for an extended period (writing lunch checks, signing papers, etc) please use the parking lot and not the driveway.

Everyone is on a schedule and no one wants to be late for work. It is always a good idea to leave home early enough to allow extra time for the unexpected. We live in South Dakota, and we all know that traffic slows a lot when the roads get slippery. Leave earlier on bad weather days to allow for slower traffic.

AFTERNOON

Parking and waiting is in the right lane only!

The left lane is for moving cars or for a quick pick up. Stops in the left lane for more than ten seconds will cause the system to break down. This system works well when everyone cooperates. You will notice that many parents meet their children at predetermined locations in the parking lot or on Dakota Street.

Please make arrangements ahead of time for your child to be picked up very soon after school is dismissed at 3:10pm.

STUDENTS MUST BE DROPPED OFF & PICKED UP ON THE SOUTH SIDE! THE NORTH SIDE IS RESERVED FOR BUSSES!



THE OUTSIDE DOORS WILL OPEN AT 7:30AM. ALL STUDENTS GETTING DROPPED OFF (EXCLUDING BUS RIDERS) MUST ENTER THROUGH THE MAIN DOORS AND PROCEED TO THE GYMNASIUM. STUDENTS EATING BREAKFAST SHOULD REPORT IMMEDIATELY TO THE CAFETERIA. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO STOP AT THEIR LOCKERS BEFORE BREAKFAST OR REPORTING TO THE GYMNASIUM.

ATTENDANCE

SOUTH DAKOTA LAW AND SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY REQUIRE STUDENTS TO ATTEND SCHOOL REGULARLY. IT IS OUR PRACTICE TO INFORM PARENTS OF DEVELOPING ABSENCE TRENDS REGARDLESS OF THE REASON. WE WILL CONTACT YOU AT APPROXIMATELY 6 ABSENCES AND AGAIN AT 12 ABSENCES, SHOULD THEY ACCUMULATE.

AFTER THAT, WE ARE REQUIRED TO REPORT TO THE DISTRICT TRUANCY OFFICER AND STATES ATTORNEY WHO WILL DETERMINE IF FURTHER ACTION IS APPROPRIATE. PLEASE HELP US AVOID THIS! THE MOST IMPORTANT THING TO REMEMBER IS THAT STUDENTS CAN'T LEARN IF THEY ARE NOT IN CLASS. POOR ATTENDANCE CAN CAUSE UNDUE STRESS FOR STUDENTS TRYING TO CATCH UP WHEN THEY HAVE BEEN GONE. MANY THINGS LIKE CLASS DISCUSSIONS, GROUP WORK, AND ACTIVITIES CANNOT BE DUPLICATED AND YOUR CHILD WILL MISS OUT.

PARENTS, PLEASE CALL ON OR BEFORE THE DAY OF YOUR CHILD'S ABSENCE. PLEASE DON'T WAIT FOR THE OFFICE TO CONTACT YOU.

PARENTS & GUARDIANS

If you have recently enrolled your child at Holgate, please check with the office to make sure that they have all the up to date information for your child like immunization records, address changes, contact information, etc.

If any contact or household information has changed for your family, please stop in the office so we can get your information updated; or give us a call at 725-7700.

STUDENTS

If your class schedule needs to be changed, please set aside a time to either call the office at 725-7700 or stop in before or after the school day to make the necessary changes. REMEMBER to bring your supplies with you on the first day of school, you don't want to be

without a pencil or paper!!!

SCHOOL LUNCH

The first day of school lunch will be on Wednesday, August 24th!

You can deposit money into your child's lunch account by either using the link for My School Bucks below, or you can send a green deposit slip, along with money, with your student on the first

day of school.

SCHOOL STARTS AT 8:00AM

If you arrive at school before 7:55 am you will need to go to the gymnasium or you may eat breakfast in the cafeteria and wait until you are released to go to homeroom.

If you are late coming to school, you must see Mrs. Deuel in the office and get a tardy slip.

SCHOOL ENDS AT 3:10PM

Make sure your student is picked up on time after school at the main entrance of Holgate, located on the south side. We do not have supervision for students after the 3:10pm bell.

YMCA After the Bell (225-7113) and Boys and Girls Club (225-8714) have afterschool programs available for after school supervision. The vans for these programs pick up students on the north side of Holgate.

PE CLASSES WILL NOT REQUIRE GYM UNIFORMS.

From Our Nurse 6th Grade Vaccination Requirements

One dose of Tetanus, Diptheria, Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine and one dose of Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine are REQUIRED for 6th grade entry.

These shots should be given on or after the 11th birthday. If your child is 10 years old when entering 6th grade they have 45 days after their 11th birthday to receive the vaccinations.

These requirements are specified in South Dakota Codified Law 13-28-7.1.

Please visit with your physician or Brown County Community Health Center (626-2649) to see if your child needs these vaccinations.

The Aberdeen School District Health Office asks that all parents of 6th grade students turn in the updated immunization record to the school one week prior to the first day of school

Middle School Immunization Requirements

South Dakota Codified Law 13-28-7.1 requires that students enrolled in a public school meet certain immunization requirements. Minimum requirements are defined as having received:

*Four or more doses of DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) vaccine. One dose must be given after age 4.

- *One dose of Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) given after age 11.
- *Four or more doses of Polio Vaccine, with one dose given after age 4.
- *Two doses of MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) given after age 12 months.
- *Two doses of Varicella (Chicken Pox) given after age 12 months.
- *One dose of MCV4 (Meningococcal) given after age 11.

IF your child is 10 years old when entering 6th grade they have 45 days after their 11th birthday to receive the Tdap and MCV4 vaccinations.

These vaccinations can be obtained through your family physician or the Brown County Community Health Center, 626-2649.

6th Grade: Please have these immunizations taken care of before the first day of school. You may drop off your proof of immunization at the office ahead of time or bring a copy with you during the parent/student orientation on August 22nd from 5:30pm - 6:30pm.

SCHOOL LUNCH

School lunch will offer a wide variety of choices for students. K-5 2 Options 6-8 4 Options 9-12 8 Options

All meals include an entrée choice, a hot vegetable plus the unlimited Fruit & Veggie Bar, and milk choices.

SCHOOL LUNCH ACCOUNTS

Enclosed is the District's Lunch Account Policy for the 22-23 School year. The District allows students to charge up to two meals. When an account balance is below \$10, students receive a minimum of three reminders to bring lunch money. At the point, when an account reaches a negative of 2 meals parents will be notified by **letter**. If the student is a free student they still will be able to purchase a school lunch, but no extra entrées will be allowed.

A Point of Sale (POS) software system is used for the school lunch program. Please note the following important information:

Each student will have his/her own individual <u>Student Account</u>.

 If sending cash with a student, place in a sealed envelope, along with the student's name and lunch account number.

We are not responsible for lost, unidentified, or stolen cash.
 Deposits should be turned in by <u>9:00 a.m.</u> at the student's school.

Lunch Account Deposits must be made before school

starts. Because we receive an overwhelming amount of deposits the morning of the first day of school, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to input all deposits into accounts before the lunch period begins. To ensure that your deposit is credited to your student's lunch account on the first day of school, please send your first deposit, for each student in your family, to the address below:

Applications for Free and Reduced-price meals can be filled out any time during the school year.

Applications can be picked-up at the District Administration Building, or are available at the school website on the "Food Service" page.

Students approved for Free & Reduced price meals from the previous year will be on a 30 day carry over. All other students will be on Paid status unless an application is filled out.

DIET MODIFICATIONS

Families are responsible for notifying the School Food Service if their child requires a diet modification because of a life threatening disability. A licensed physician must provide specific written medical documentation.

SNACKS

For Middle/High School students, snack items will be available during the lunch period.

Snack items offered include:

Fruit drinks Ice cream Water Granola Bars Beef Jerky Yogurt

All snacks meet standards set by the District's Wellness Policy.

EXTRA ENTRÉE - EXTRA MILK

All students, at an extra cost, can purchase an additional entrée or milk offered as part of the school lunch program.

For example if a student wants a second entrée, or an additional entrée, like a slice of pizza, then that entrée can be selected in the lunch line and charged to the student's account.

Extra entrees are only sold to students who first purchase a school lunch.

All students can have extra servings of these with no charge: Canned Fruit Fresh Fruit Vegetables Salads

If a student is free or reduced they may receive one entrée with their meal but they must have money in their account to purchase any extra
