Expectations:

A driver's license is a privilege and responsibility.

The state of South Dakota requires a student to do the following to pass a driver's education course:

- Attend 30 hours of classroom instruction
- Pass the classroom course with 80% or better
- Drive 6 hours with an instructor
- Observe 6 hours of driving with an instructor
- Pass the driving test with 80% or better

Class hours are non-negotiable. If a student misses more than 1 hour of classroom instruction the student will fail the course. They may retake the course at a later date for the retake fee.

Class scores are non-negotiable. The final classroom score is what the student earns and no retakes are permitted.

Driving Hours: If a student has an emergency and needs to reschedule their driving time, it is the student's responsibility to contact the instructor to make arrangements. Students are encouraged to contact the instructor at least 48 hours prior to their scheduled time to allow the instructor an opportunity to reschedule. If a student does not make-up missed driving time they will not pass the driving portion of the course. Please know your schedule before signing up for your driving times. Rescheduling is based on instructor and car availability.

Observation Hours: If a student misses more than one hour of observation, he/she may make up missed hours by riding with another student.
