1. Complete form on computer, using Kami or a pdf editor.
2. Print out application.
3. Student AND parent sign agreement page.
4. Turn in your application and transcript to Mrs. Miggetto by April 6. (Students keep page 1.)

Student Agreement (Read carefully and sign the following)

All students applying for local scholarships must be Westville High School students. Many scholarship donors require the recipient to meet certain conditions to be eligible to receive scholarship funding.

Scholarship awards in excess of \$500 will be divided into 2 equal payments with half given for the fall semester and the second half for the spring semester. Scholarships funds not claimed by February 28 of the following year will transfer to the scholarship program general fund for new applicants.

Student is responsible for notifying WHS Scholarship Director of any changes of named college. Delay in doing so may delay scholarship funds to be sent. The WHS Scholarship Director will provide a form for each applicant to complete to verify the school of your choice, ID# and amount to be sent. Student and Parent should review the document carefully. Once the proper documentation is completed, scholarship funds will be disbursed. Fall semester payments will be mailed by September 1st. Spring semester payments will be mailed by February 1st. It is also recommended that the student follow up with the college bursar/scholarship office to make sure the funds are credited to their account.

The Westville High School Scholarship Committee and the Westville School District are not responsible for the payment to the recipient if the donor does not pay the scholarship.
