Milan Community Sports Fans,

One common question I get asked from community members is what can I do to help our Sports Programs at Milan C-2? Beyond getting involved with our fantastic Milan Athletic Booster Club in a variety of ways – another HUGE need we have is for MSHSAA Registered Officials. It is a dire need because without officials we can't have games!

Our state has a significant deficit in Officials for ALL SPORTS - as many Officials are retiring without new ones to replace them. Just yesterday, Tuesday September 6th, several areas schools had to cancel games due to lack of baseball/softball umpires. Also many area schools have had to move Friday Night Football Games to Thursday evenings or Saturdays due to the Officials shortage. Things are only going to get worse – until we find more officials. There have already been several contests this fall in Milan that were in danger of being cancelled due to official's availability.

Registering to be a MSHSAA Official is not as difficult as you think. You first register online for certain sports and then MSHSAA sends you a Rule Book. After you pass a Sport-Specific Rules Test and order the gear needed – you are ready to officiate! Currently we have only 1 part-time registered official that resides in Milan for basketball and football. We currently have 0 registered officials that live in Milan for baseball, softball and track. The pay is competitive and many schools pay mileage/travel costs associated with the event. It is a rewarding way to make some extra money, stay connected to the sports you love and help our young people have opportunities to compete.

If you are interested in starting the process to become an official – please don't hesitate to contact me. I can help with starting things and get you connected with local officials to begin scheduling games. Thank you for considering helping our student-athletes in this way!
