

# Crawford Independent School District



On August 30, 2021, the Crawford ISD Board of Trustees adopted a decreased tax rate and a surplus budget for the 2021-2022 fiscal year which began on September 1, 2021. Trustees voted to approve a decreased total tax rate this school year of \$1.163078 per \$100 of home valuation. The new lower tax rate is made up of \$.960300 in maintenance and operations and \$.202778 in the interest and sinking rate. Over the last three years, the total tax rate has dropped from \$1.293160 in 2019 to \$1.20737 in 2020 and \$1.163078 this year. Understanding that tax bills will increase due to increased valuations from the appraisal district, the Crawford ISD board and administration will continue to work to ensure the efficient use of taxpayer dollars while delivering the most effective instructional programs to the students of our community. We appreciate the unwavering support of this community to provide the highest quality education to our children.
