## James Emerson Eastman Band Scholarship Fund - \$1000 Scholarship

Applicants must

1. Been a member of either the Choir and/or Band at Ridgedale for four years
2. Have at least a 3.0 grade point average
3. Going to either Major or Minor in Music in college

## Esther Fleming Memorial Scholarship - \$500 Scholarship

1. A graduate of Ridgedale High School for the current school year.
2. Major in education
3. Planning to attend Ohio State University - Marion Branch Campus

If no individuals are planning to major in education at the Marion Branch Campus, then the scholarship may be awarded to the son or daughter of a Ridgedale staff member who is majoring in education at another college.

### **The Craig Scholarship Fund**

Must be a Ridgedale High school Senior with a 3.25 or better grade point average

Relatives of Diane Craig are NOT eligible

Consideration factors:

Demonstrated commitment to their education.

Intended major of sciences, medicine, health, engineering, or education.

Good character, service, citizenship.

Attended Ridgedale all four years.

### **Adam Johnston Memorial Scholarship Fund**

1. Must be a Senior at Ridgedale High School and attended Ridgedale his/her entire Senior Year

2. Be registered to attend an accredited college or university located in Ohio which normally maintains a regular faculty and curriculum and normally has a regularly enrolled body of pupils or students in attendance at the place where its educational activities are regularly carried on for a course of study that will prepare them for a career.

3. Have scored in the upper 50th percentiles of the ACT, SAT or other national standardized test commonly used to select students for the applicant's planned course of study.

Have timely prepared and filed the application and accompanying documents designated by the Marion Foundation for this scholarship.

1. Must have attended either Pleasant or Ridgedale High School all four years

2. Must have at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average
