#### I. Call to order

This will include adding fiber optic to the upper level of the school, more laptops and smartboards. ATC has a good technology plan and as a result has benefited greatly from the technology funds. - d) Up to \$200 was approved for Dana Johnson's visiting artist program this year with Carol Ware. A request was made that the resulting artwork be hung in the main office and be on display for Flaming Chicken Earth Day Event.
- e) Up to \$145 was approved for prizes for the 7<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade poetry prizes for Ms. Johnson's class.
- f) Mr. Mathis is looking for funding and support for the High School State Chess tournament. Hotel and meals will be needing some funding. Tabled until next meeting. Thinking of ways we can help.
- g) Hampton Sides will be visiting ATC to do an author visit. Copies of his book *Ghost Soldiers* need to be funded. Ms. Lumley's funds can cover all but approximately \$230 of the cost of the books. It was suggested that parents be asked to purchase a copy for their child or donate \$ in support of this fund.
