Fundraising Strategies & Events

- A. Andie is working with Sam's Club to establish a day when ATC can sell Farolitos for Physics. Farolito bags will be worked on by students prior to December.
- B. Andie is working on getting a few parking lots (Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe and the county courthouse) for ATC to supervise and collect \$10 parking fees on Zozobra night as a fund raiser.

Support for Jaiden Patel

A. Jaiden is a 10th grader at ATC. He has had brain cancer since he was 2. He has been accepted for an experimental treatment in Houston. His family insurance will no longer cover his treatment. The treatment in Houston alone is \$300,000. Travel costs are extra. ATC students want to raise money to help his family. They will be selling t-shirts at \$20 (they have 150 shirts). Students who purchase the shirts will wear them every Friday. There was a big send-off for Jaiden at school on Aug. 25th. The Santa Fe New Mexican and KRQE will cover his story this week. The PTSC wishes to help support Jaiden's family. If you are able to donate air miles for their travel, please do it for the family (the costs are greatly reduced).

Fundraising Requests

A. ATC will host its largest cross-country invitational this year, with 31 teams participating. He is looking for someone with a food-handler's license to serve at the event.

- B. Eric Carlson has asked the PTSC to help the music program by purchasing an instrument each year for either the Acoustic Americana or Marimba class. This year he would like a mandolin (\$392 plus shipping). PTSC supports Mr. Carlson, but before allocating the funds Andie will speak with Mr. Borrego who owns Borrego's Guitars to see if he can help with the costs.
- C. The ATC sports teams need first aid kits. Andie will reach out to Christus St. Vincent Hospital and Presbyterian Medical Services for financial help, but also recommends the coaches request funds from ATC as these are a safety issue for the school.
- D. Tim Host has requested that the PTSC purchase two pole-vault poles for the track and field team. This request has been tabled until the next meeting. The poles aren't needed until Track & Field begins.

Open Floor

- A. Rhonda Gardner offered coupons for the Wine and Jazz Festival in Albuquerque. Her husband is a photographer who will have a booth at the festival.
- B. Holland Shepherd and Thomas Moore intend to attend a meeting (8/25, after the PTSC meeting) of parents of the swim team to discuss how the cutting of the swim team was handled. They will be attending the Governing Council meeting on Thursday, August 27th to discuss this with ATC.
