If you do not receive a notice, and you have concerns, please take a moment to email the teacher to share your concerns, and they will work with you. Conferences for all students will occur from October 19 through October 21.

Thank you in advance for arriving at your scheduled student conference on time. You may want to bring a shortlist of questions you intend to ask in order to use the limited time efficiently and to avoid forgetting what was on your mind prior to the meeting. Students have a role with conferences so please plan on them attending with you. Please understand that while we know that time for Middle School conferences is extremely limited, we are committed to communicating with families throughout the school year to support your student.
