







# Jenkins High School 1964-'65




The members of the Jenkins High School Beta Club elected Miss Shelby Jean Shelby Beta Club Queen of 1965.





To the students of Jenkins, the untimely death of Coach Jim Summers was a tragic loss. There are pleasant memories for those who knew him. He was respected and admired by the faculty as well as the student body. His basketball boys were the "sons" he never had.
