If a student is **driving** in the parade, he/she must pay a \$10 registration fee to Ms. Naramore by Wednesday, September 22nd. Any student **riding with another student must turn in a permission slip along with the driver. Therefore, ALL students driving or riding in the parade MUST turn in their permission slip(s).**

All students participating in the parade 6-12th grade must turn in a parade permission form to Ms. Naramore in room #8 by Wednesday, September 22nd letting them know what they are riding in and with whom.

LUNCH INFORMATION

Normal lunches will be served through the cafeteria on Friday, September 24.

STUDENTS NOT PARTICIPATING IN THE PARADE

Students who do not wish to participate in the parade will remain at school where they will be supervised by teachers and staff. Students may also sign out in the front lobby at 12:00 with a note from a parent. Once a student signs out, he/she must leave school grounds and may not participate in parade activities. Students may ride the bus to a designated location to watch the parade. Once the parade is over, these students will be bused back to RBSHS to catch their buses as normal.

Buses will run as normal at the end of the school day for those students remaining at school.

PARADE DAY RULES

1. The following vehicles will be allowed in the parade:

- o Cars
- o Trucks
- o 4-Wheelers/utility vehicles drivers and riders must wear helmets
- o Side by Side (Gators) are allowed but must have working seatbelts. (Drivers and riders must wear helmets if their vehicle does NOT have a front windshield)
- o Tractors
- o Class Floats

NO HORSES, MOTORCYCLES, OR GO-CARTS

2. STUDENTS MUST REMAIN IN VEHICLES AT ALL TIMES for the duration of the parade; THEY SHOULD NOT “HANG OUT” OF VEHICLES.
3. Students will NOT be allowed to ride in the backs of trucks/vehicles driven by other students. They should be sitting in seats that provide factory-installed working seatbelts.
4. Each vehicle must have enough working seatbelts for the number of people who ride in that vehicle.
5. Each vehicle must be decorated displaying school spirit format only in order to be allowed in the parade. ANY WRITTEN MATERIAL OR DECORATIONS MUST STAY WITHIN SCHOOL POLICY GUIDELINES. VIOLATING THIS WILL CAUSE A STUDENT TO BE REMOVED FROM THE PARADE AND REPRIMANDED IN SCHOOL THE FOLLOWING WEEK.
6. All candy must be individually wrapped and must not be thrown in a way that is forceful or that would cause harm to individuals on the parade route.

PARADE ROUTE

The parade will leave from Red Boiling Springs School at 1:30 p.m.on Friday, September 24, 2021.

The Parade will travel from RBSHS and go off the hill toward Witcher Hollow Road. At Witcher Hollow Road, it will take a right and travel to East Main Street where it will vere right to pass the hotels and park. It will continue to Main Street. The parade will cross through the intersection toward Macon Bank. At Macon Bank, it turns left onto McClure Street. It will follow McClure Street to Hwy 52. At Hwy 52, the parade will turn right and go to the Marathon to circle the parking lot and turn left back onto Hwy 52. It will then turn and circle Spivey Street to Carthage Road and back to Hwy 52. The parade will then travel Lafayette Road past the funeral home, city hall, and fire dept. It will continue downtown and pass the Palace. After passing The Palace it will turn right back onto Hillcrest Drive and back up to RBSHS.
