Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program: Florida Academics, Florida Medallion and The Gold Seal Endorsement Program.

The Gold Seal Scholarship focuses on students who have performed well in career preparatory programs. It recognizes and rewards excellence for academic achievement and career preparation. Specific courses and/or course sequence is required to earn the FLGSBFS. See your Counselor or Career Specialist to learn more about earning this scholarship.



Career Pathways program is a high school technology program linked with a post-secondary program which may lead to a certificate program, associate's degree, and/or bachelor's degree. Through academics and technical studies, the student will build his/her competencies in communication, mathematics and science.



Dual Enrollment students may earn free college credits and high school credits their junior and/or senior year at SJR-STATE, DSC or SFC. Students must meet the criteria of a 3.0 UGPA and have a college placement score (CPT, SAT, ACT, or PERT) on file.



Career Dual Enrollment is available to students seeking an a CTC (Vocational Certificate) associated with their CTE program of study. You must have a 2.0 UGPA and college placement test scores (ACT, SAT CPT, or PERT) on file. Some courses have age requirements.

Emergency Medical Responder

This program offers a sequence of courses that provides coherent and rigorous content aligned with challenging academic standards and relevant technical knowledge and skills needed to prepare for further education and careers in the Health Science career cluster; provides technical skill proficiency, and includes competency-based applied learning that contributes to the academic knowledge, higher-order reasoning and problem-solving skills, work attitudes, general employability skills, technical skills, and occupation-specific skills, and knowledge of all aspects of Health Science career cluster.

This instructional program prepares individuals to provide initial care to sick or injured persons or as ambulance drivers and attendants. An Emergency Medical Responder may use this training for employment. The Emergency Medical Responder is the first to arrive at the scene of an injury but does not have the primary responsibility for treating and transporting the injured person(s). Emergency Medical Responders may include law enforcement, lifeguard, fire services or basic life support non-licensed personnel who act as part of an organized emergency medical services team.

Emergency Medical Responder Opportunities

This program offers a sequence of courses that provides coherent and rigorous content aligned with challenging academic standards and relevant technical knowledge and skills needed to prepare for further education and careers in the Law, Public Safety & Security career cluster; provides technical skill proficiency, and includes competency-based applied learning that contributes to the academic knowledge, higher-order reasoning and problem-solving skills, work attitudes, general employability skills, technical skills, and occupation-specific skills, and knowledge of all aspects of the Law, Public Safety & Security career cluster. Students can continue their education in the Public Safety career pathway at St John's River State College or First Coast Technical College.

Program Structure

The Emergency Medical Responder 3 program is a planned sequence of instruction consisting of three courses that will provide the EMR for additional postsecondary instruction. When the recommended sequence is followed, the structure will allow students to complete specified portions of the program for employment or to continue to post-secondary education in the fields of Law, Public Safety & Security or Health Science career cluster.
