# Should you win the 2021 Halloween Queen Scholarship Contest, your duties are as follows:

- 1. Ride in the Brown County Fair Parade (TBD) and any other local parades you would like to participate in on your own. For the Brown County Fair Parade, contact the queen coordinator in early June.
- 2. Notify queen committee of school to send scholarship check. *Please notify the queen coordinator as soon as possible to allow enough time to get the scholarship to your school.*
- 3. Email your Queen picture (the portrait from Deb's Images) and a letter to the queen coordinator promoting the Halloween Queen Contest that can be put in the newspaper. (by July 31, 2022)
- 4. Keep your sash and crown to wear in the following year's parade. (Monday, Oct 31, 2022)
- 5. You're invited to attend the 2022 Halloween Queen Scholarship Contest Judging. Give a welcoming speech to the new contestants for 2022 and visit with them before throughout the evening. (date TBD likely Sunday, October 30, 2022)
- 6. You <u>must</u> attend the crowning ceremony on October 31, 2022; then your reign is complete. *The queen coordinator will let you know the agenda for the day.*
