

# '21-'22 salaries, Safe Return Plan on FISD agenda

Salaries and a Safe Return-To-School plan for 2021-22 are on the agenda for the Forsan ISD Board of Trustees when it meets at 6 p.m. Monday in the Superintendent's Office, 411 W. Sixth Street in Forsan.

According to the meeting's agenda, the trustees will consider salaries for 2021-2022, including all staff, administration and the superintendent. The board will also consider a Staff Early Resignation Notification Incentive Policy, according to the agenda.

Earlier in the meeting, the board will consider its regular Consent Agenda, which includes the

2021-2022 Safe Return-To-School plan. No further details of the plan are included on the agenda.

Other items to be considered during the meeting include reports from the district's Junior/Senior High School principal, the Elementary School principal, the Athletic Director, and the Superintendent.

The agenda notes that the Superintendent's report will include reports on enrollment, a preview of future agenda items, the second and third installments of the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER II and ESSER III) grants including survey data and input, and data from the State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR) test including board goals for

test improvement.

Other items on the Consent Agenda include approval of the minutes of the May 10 and May 14 regular meetings; monthly financials including revenue and expense report; investment report; activity report and list of bills; board policy updates; and the annual reaffirmation of the district's investment policy.

Other items on the meeting's agenda include a change of date or cancellation of the July board meeting, and personnel issues including hiring and resignations.

A time for public comment is provided at the start of the meeting.
