

FINAL EXAMS

Student Final Exam Incentive



- Students may be able to opt out of taking the final exam ONLY if they meet the requirements below. This "opt out" is decided by each individual course.
 - Must have at least a 70% in the course at the cut-off date.
 - No more than two tardies to the class.
 - No skips or evening detentions.
 - No Out of School Suspensions or In-School Interventions.

Students who meet the opt-out requirements can still elect to take the final exam for any course to attempt to increase their grade.







All seniors, regardless of income, should complete the FAFSA each year.


The FAFSA will be completed using your **2020** tax documents. Become familiar with Federal Student Aid by visiting https://fafsa.ed.gov/.

Please bring your PCHS Chromebook.

You and your student will **EACH** need to create an **FSA ID**. This can be completed at https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm. Your student SHOULD NOT use your email address or his/her/their Pekin High email address to create his/her/their ID as he/she/they will not have access to it after graduation. Each **FSA ID** must use a unique email address. Make sure to write this information down in a safe place.


