

2021-2022 Bridge Street Middle School LSIC Goals

Goal 1: Family and Community Events

BSMS will host a family and community related event at least twice per year. One event will take place in the fall, and one event will take place in the spring. These events will tie together families, community partnerships, and staff.

Goal 2: Decreasing Minor Disciplinary Infractions

BSMS will aim to keep a low number of and continue decreasing minor disciplinary actions by increasing staff PD using behavioral management charts, strengthening our tier 2 and tier 3 services, and working to counsel both families and students. During the 2020-2021 school year, BSMS had 178 Category 1 and Category 2 infractions. This information is not used for WVEIS purposes, but is tracked throughout the calendar school year. This year, BSMS will continue monitoring minor infractions each nine week period to identify weaknesses in our system and continue strengthening the aforementioned.

Goal 3: Core Academic Achievement

BSMS will use MAPping and PD to increase math and reading scores on the 2021-2022 GSA. Through the innovation team, a MAPping document has been created wherein teachers explore content specific CSO's, provide an IMA after teaching that section of standards, building in a week of re-teach as needed as well as enrichment where appropriate, and then an additional IMA to show growth patterns. BSMS aims to see an overall increase in testing scores of 3% in each grade level for the 2021-2022 school year.
