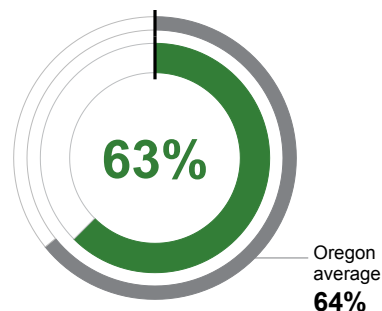
CLASS SIZE

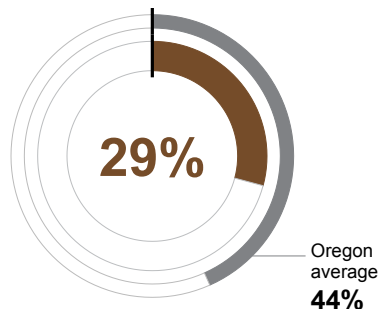

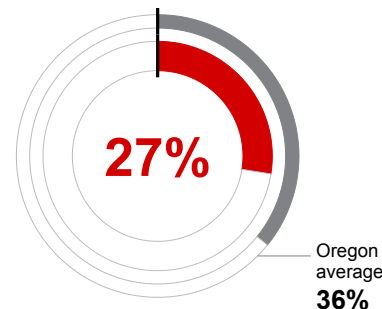
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Academic Progress

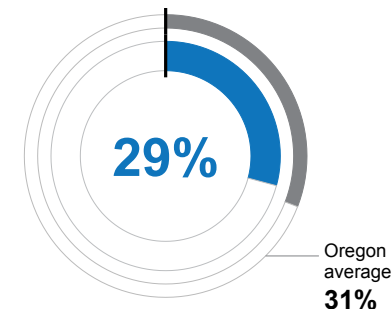
INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

About Our School

BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

At Greenwood we strive to help students navigate peer conflicts and unsafe behaviors through conscious discipline and green zone strategies while following board policy. We encourage safe choices and positive peer relationships through regular character education instruction. We are focused on understanding the impact of trauma on students and providing strategies for impacted students. School Resource Officers help build positive relationships with students and encourage safe and positive choices.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Greenwood students benefit from a number of activities beyond the core instruction program. These include students leadership, after-school sports, book groups, Fiddle Club, and various friendship groups.

PARENT ENGAGEMENT

Greenwood's Title I program leads a number of parent outreach and engagement efforts. We host multiple Family Fun Nights each year. We encourage parents to volunteer and become involved in our school and their child's education. We also have an active PTS that helps support and enrich the lives of our students and families.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Greenwood recognizes the great community we have and their desire to support our students. Opportunities like our sport programs and field trips would not be possible without community support. Additionally, we have fantastic donors that help support our school community. We continue to find ways to engage the community through regular newsletters and school website. Teachers and administrators welcome community participants to attend regular events and experience the great things our staff and students are doing.
