School-wide parent letter:

MESSAGE FROM SUPERINTENDENT KYLE KONOLD

I know that many of you are concerned regarding the recent developments on the spread of coronavirus COVID-19. Let me reassure you that Delta continues to work closely with a coalition of partners, including the Clark County School District, Office of the Governor, Clark County Government, the Southern Nevada Health District, and other agencies on a cohesive community response to protect the health and well-being of our students and staff.

As mentioned in previous messages, at this time, there are no confirmed cases of coronavirus within Delta Academy or even within CCSD. However, we are taking additional precautions to ensure our schools are clean and disinfected regularly in order for our buildings to remain conducive to learning.

I ask that you help Delta in preventing the spread of germs by reminding children of everyday actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses:

Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer

Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth

Cover cough and sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash

A few things you can do at home to prevent the spread of germs include disinfecting surfaces that your child touches often such as their backpacks, doorknobs, and light switches.

As always, we ask that you keep your child at home from school if they may be sick. Please reassure your children and keep them positive as they may be worried about current events. Keep them energized about learning and excited about attending school as we begin the 4th quarter.

Please know that Delta Academy in partnership with CCSD is collaborating with the Southern Nevada Health District on a regular basis. The health district has activated an information phone line for those who may have questions about coronavirus. Currently, the phone line is staffed Monday – Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and may be reached by calling (702) 759-INFO (4636).


