- In 2008, WestCare Charter School changed its name to The Delta Academy. Delta is the mathematic symbol for change.
- The Delta Academy student enrollment increased from 61 students in the 07 school year to 125 students in the 08 school year.
- The Delta Academy proudly continues to offer small class sizes in all academic areas (15 or less per class).
- CCSD granted the Delta Academy approval to offer distance education courses for our students.
- The Delta Academy offers a hybrid instructional model.
 Students may take courses on-line or on-site.

Goals and Objectives

Goal 1

Increase attendance for all students in all grade levels.

Objective(s):

Students will increase their average daily attendance rates by 25% from the same month in the 2007 - 2008 school year.

Goal 2

Increase student achievement on the HSPE in mathematics for 11th graders.

Objective(s):

Between September 08 and April 09, student performance in mathematics will increase across all subgroups from 33% to 66%. IEP subgroups will demonstrate additional increases from 0% to 50% in mathematics.




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Per-Pupil Expenditures 2007-2008
