

**SCHOOL ASSEMBLIES**

The Yale Board of Education believes that a student's education will be enriched through the occasional assembling of the student body to observe science demonstrations, listen to lectures, participate in class plays, and other similar activities.

Assemblies will be held during the school hours and will be a part of the school program. The assemblies shall be planned by the school administration. All students and teachers will attend unless excused.

Student behavior in assemblies is a reflection on the character of the school. Students should enter the auditorium in an orderly manner and seat themselves immediately upon entering their assigned sections. Students may speak only in low voices until the program begins, at which time all talking must cease. Students should give their complete attention to the program being presented, expressing appreciation with appropriate applause.
