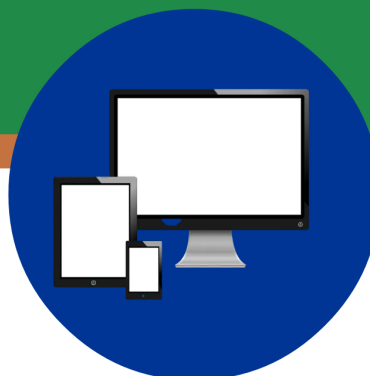

MORE THAN A SCHOOL MEAL APPLICATION

Snook ISD School Nutrition Services has received a waiver from the Texas Department of Agriculture which will allow all S1SD students to eat school breakfast and lunch at no charge for the 2021-2022 school year. Each day students may receive one breakfast and one lunch at no charge. Second meals, extra entrees, and ala carte food items will still be available for purchase in the cafeteria. You are not required to have an approved meal application to receive meals; however, an approved meal application provides many benefits to your family and your school.

- BRAZOS VALLEY FOOD BANK BACKPACK PROGRAM
- REDUCED HOME INTERNET FEES (EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT)
- YOUR SCHOOL WILL RECEIVE E-RATE FUNDING WHICH IS USED FOR INTERNET ACCESS & INFRASTRUCTURE
