 - b. I, Misty Lucherk, move that we accept the recommendation of the Superintendent to employ Sierra Richard as a teacher on a one year probationary contract. The motion was seconded by Brian Jaeger. Motion passed unanimously.
 - c. A motion was made by Mr. Jaeger and seconded by Mr. Bostain to accept the resignation of Kathryn D. Shedd effective at the end of the school year. Motion passed unanimously.
 - d. The board also announced the resignation of Rachel Harmel effective at the end of the school year and the retirement of Kathy Ladewig effective August 31, 2017.
- 11. A motion was made by Mr. Cox and seconded by Mr. Bostain to go to executive session at 8:31 p.m. Motion passed unanimously. Board returned to open session at 9:03 p.m.
