Chromebooks

Your child may be bringing home a yellow Technology Student Use Agreement home yesterday from their advisory class if they are 9th-12th graders. For this school year, all 9th-12th graders will be issued a Chromebook for them to take back and forth to school and use this technology during all their classes during the day. A charger will go home with them and we are asking that each student comes to school with their device fully charged. We do not have capabilities to have charging stations at school. 11th/12th Grade Transcript Review and Update on Graduation Requirements

Next week in 12th grade Advisory seniors will be doing a Transcript Review to make sure they have all the credits they need to graduate in June. The district has changed a few graduation requirements, this past July at the School Board meeting, and we will notify seniors of those changes. As students prepare for the next steps after graduation they will make sure they understand their transcript and begin to apply to colleges this fall.

The week of September 27th 11th graders will be doing the same activity in their advisory class.

Parent Support Tips: Academic Planners, Attendance, and first 3 weeks of school

How can you support your child in being successful in school?

- Attendance: Students need to be on time to school. Please help your child be on time to school. Lots of kids want to come early to school so they can prepare for the day, hang out with friends, or ask teachers for help. Our doors open at 7:30AM every day of school.
- Academic Planners: These are required for 7th-9th grade and students are using them in each of their classes. Staying organized and managing their time is sometimes difficult when they may just want to hang out with friends and get overwhelmed with homework. Helping them with task lists and being able to cross items off feels really good would be a tremendous help for them. 10th-12th graders can pick up a 5 ½ by 8 School Academic Planner to use this year anytime in the front office. We have 60 of them so remind them to stop by and get one.
- First 3 weeks of school-this is a crucial time for students to complete all their classroom assignments (in class and homework), getting behind in your assignments becomes overwhelming for them by the 4th week and hard to stay on top of things once they have started going down the road.
