**1. KCC MOU**

Presenter: SUPERINTENDENT


Dr. Roberto Gutierrez, President of Klamath Community College (KCC) introduced himself and Julie Murray-Jensen, Vice President of External Programs. Murray-Jensen presented a brief overview of the past two academic years with KCC Lake County. She noted that it was a modest beginning but it has grown exponentially. Gutierrez noted that synchronous is the way of the future, one teacher and multiple locations. The accomplishments were then highlighted. Welding was launched in Spring and there are nine community members enrolled in that program. The goals moving forward were reviewed, which included the additional synchronous classrooms around the county and the increase in the Advanced Diploma Program (ADP) student enrollment. The 2014-2017 strategic goals are to increase services at the ILC and to continue ongoing development of the community resources and grant funding for the completion of the facility. KCC – Lake and Rural Oregon continues to grow and provide much needed educational services to rural communities. Gutierrez noted that 70% of middle class jobs now require some type of education beyond high school. Chavez noted that the Dual Credit Coordinator from KCC spent a full day with the teachers at Lakeview High School (LHS) working with them one on one. Gallagher advised the board that they have a draft copy of the Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) with KCC before them to review and ask questions. There were no questions from the board. Gutierrez noted that this MOU continues KCC's relationship with LCSD # 7 and the ILC that Mr. Gallagher started. Gallagher requested that the board close work session and go into regular session for approval of the MOU.


