Town of Fleming Ordinance #1-2014

An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance #1-2013 Concerning the Retail Sales Tax Within the Town of Fleming, Colorado.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FLEMING, COLORADO:

WHEREAS, the Town desires that industrial and commercial electricity sales be exempt from taxation under Referred Measure 2Y; and

WHEREAS, the Town passed Ordinance No. 1-2013 to clarify its intent regarding the taxing the sales of electricity; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1-2014 has within it an exemption for the sales of electricity, coal, wood, gas, fuel oil or coke as specified in Section 39-26-715(1)(a)(II), C.R.S., and

WHEREAS, the Town of Fleming finds it is in the Town's best interest to repeal Ordinance No. 1-2013 in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FLEMING, COLORADO:

Section 1: All sections of Ordinance No. 1-2013 are hereby repealed in their entirety and replaced to its original referred Measure 2Y Ordinance No. 1-2012.

Section 2: The Board of Trustees finds, determines, and declares that this Ordinance is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety in the Town of Fleming, Colorado. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
