Ordinance No. 2-1999

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-2.16C OF ORDINANCE #1-1982 (AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE #1-1994) RELATING TO WEEDS, TALL GRASS, AND BRUSH, AND THE CUTTING AND REMOVAL OF SUCH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF FLEMING, COLORADO:

THAT Section 3-2-16.C. TERMS DEFINED. The term "brush" used in this ordinance is hereby construed to be volunteer growth of brushes and such as is growing out of place at the location where growing, and shall include all cuttings from trees and bushes; also, high and rank shrubbery growth which may conceal filthy deposits.

The term "weed" used in this ordinance is hereby construed to be an unsightly, useless, troublesome or injurious herbaceous plant including those weeds listed in Title 35 Article 5.5 of the Colorado Noxious Weed Act. This ordinance will also include the dandelion or other such plant that is out of place at the location where growing, and shall include all rank vegetable growth which exhales unpleasant and noxious odors and also high rank vegetable growth that may conceal filthy deposits.

The term "tall grass" as used in this ordinance is hereby construed to be any grass of any variety which exceeds eight (8) inches in height.
