- 2. Save your work periodically and make sure you have saved prior to printing.
- 3. Do not print web pages:
 - a. Copy and paste the information into a Word or AppleWorks document.
 - b. Select all the text and change to a standard font (Helvetica, Geneva, etc.).
 - c. With all text still selected choose black as the font color.
 - d. Run print preview to insure that the page orientation is correct.
 - e. Print.
- 4. No backpacks are allowed in the lab.
- 5. Federal copyright rules/guidelines are posted in each lab. It is your responsibility to know and follow these rules/guidelines.
- 6. The district's Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) is posted in each lab. It is your responsibility to know and follow our AUP.
- 7. Keyboard shortcuts are posted in each lab to help you become more efficient.
- 8. Straighten up your work area chair, mouse, keyboard, and monitor- when you leave the lab.
