MINUTES OF PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS BUDGET AND
PROPOSED TAX RATE
AUGUST 30, 2021

The Board of Trustees of Burton Independent School District held a public meeting to discuss the budget and proposed tax rate and then vote to adopt the budget and tax rate on Monday, August 30, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. in the Burton Independent School District Administration Office.

The following business was transacted:

1. The meeting was called to order by President Misty Lucherk. A prayer was given by Jeff Harmel, and the pledge of allegiance was led by David Warner, Sr.
2. The 2021-2022 budget and proposed tax rate were discussed. There were no public comments.
3. A motion was made by Ms. Putnam and seconded by Mr. Warner to adopt the 2021-2022 budget as presented. Motion passed 6-0. The adopted budget is 8,320,434.95.
4. A motion was made by Mr. Fuchs and seconded by Mr. Colvin to adopt an ordinance setting the tax rate at \$.9782 per \$100.00 valuation. The ad valorem tax rate will be distributed as follows: \$.90330 for maintenance and operation and \$.07490 for interest and sinking. Motion passed 6-0.
5. A motion was made by Mr. Harmel and seconded by Mr. Fuchs to approve budget amendments for 2020-2021 as presented. Motion passed 6-0. (Copy attached.)
6. A motion was made by Ms. Putnam and seconded by Mr. Colvin to approve a stipend for current teachers who are assigned to mentor new teachers to Burton ISD in the amount of \$200.00 each not to exceed \$2000.00. Motion passed 6-0.

7. A motion was made by Mr. Colvin and seconded by Mr. Warner to adjourn at 6:13 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
