

**NURSING SERVICES
(REGULATIONS)**

In accordance with the policy of the board of education, this regulation shall include the terms of the board's contractual relationship with the Payne County Health Department.

The Payne County Health Department will provide nursing services for:

1. Health education for faculty and students.
2. (Immunizations, venereal disease, adolescent physiology, reproductive physiology, personal hygiene, and etc.)
3. Assisting families and school children with medical, social, and emotional problems.
4. Direct the control of the communicable disease program. Providing verbal and written suggestions for care.
5. Instructing school employees and volunteers on appropriate immunization records. Assisting with annual audit as required.
6. Conducting and coordinating screening programs in the schools (hearing, vision, scoliosis).
7. Regularly scheduled visits to all schools for nurse-teacher conferences.
8. Serving as resource person for environmental problems.
9. Instructing school officials on first-aid procedures.

These services will be provided by a registered nurse with medical backup. The Payne County Health Department will provide supervision and assignment responsibilities and a minimum of twenty hours of nursing service each week.
